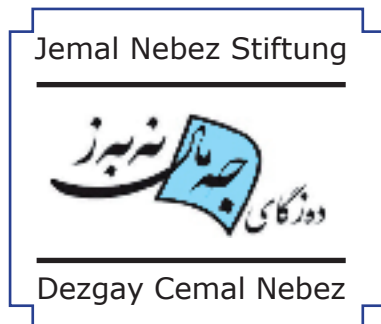

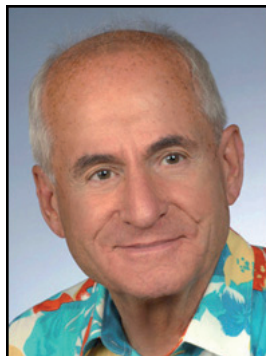

A foundation for the concerns of Kurds and Kurdistan

Jemal Nebez came to Europe in 1960/61. When he left his home region in the South of Kurdistan, he was already a mature man. He spoke several languages, had already made a name for himself as an author, and had worked for several years as a high school teacher of physics and mathematics. In Europe, he first worked as an unskilled laborer and continued his studies. He earned a doctorate in Hamburg and a degree in political science in Berlin. He spent a lot of energy to spread his knowledge about the culture of the Kurds and the conditions in Kurdistan the world. He traveled a lot in Europe, to give lectures to compatriots, He remained closely connected to the events in all parts of Kurdistan, without even once having returned in 60 years. His linguistic charisma and immense knowledge of culture and history of the Kurds and Kurdistan made his compatriots say: *Where Jemal Nebez is, there is Kurdistan.* He wrote several innovative works in very different fields.



The foundation established in the name of this great thinker and pioneer of Kurdology is such that its existence is secured in terms of the most necessary. It has no existential constraints. It does, however, need donations in order to proceed with its statutory tasks in honor of its namesake in a way that he appreciated, i.e.

in freedom for freedom

in principle for the preservation and further development of the cultural heritage of the Kurds and Kurdistan

against the forgetting of 120 years of criminal disregard and neglect of their legitimate concerns by the international organizations responsible - the League of Nations and its successor organization UN

We are based in Berlin-Wilmersdorf. Jemal Nebez is still known in the house. He used the space..Now it belongs to the foundation.

The Jemal Nebez Foundation was officially confirmed as founded on March 31, 2020, and on June 16 the decision was issued that its statutes in the version of March 20, 2020 meet the requirements for recognition of its non-profit status. The relevant documents are available on our website.



The purpose of the Jemal Nebez Foundation is the promotion of science and research, popular education and vocational training as well as of the arts and culture of the Kurds, be it in Kurdistan or around the world, in the current context or concerning their history.



- We preserve and disseminate the works of Jemal Nebez as well as knowledge about his life.
- We aim to award the Jemal Nebez Prize every other year.
- We support capable people/groups and their research/projects by awarding scholarships and training - if we can find suitable sponsors for it.

Long-term project - Library/Archive Book projects

At our premises in Berlin-Wilmersdorf we have a multifunctional room, which we want to make



available to registered users of our library at certain times after further preparatory work. In this room, the works of Jemal Nebez are housed as a special collection in a bookcase. All other books are on shelves next door.



To the right and left of the bookcase in our multifunctional room, there is storage space for our periodicals or other printed material – together with display space, for copies of newly completed book projects for example.

The multifunctional room is also suitable for online seminars and lectures, e.g. on the occasion of our Open Day.

The archive of the Jemal Nebez Foundation consisting of our namesake's personal diaries, unprinted writings, handwritten letters etc. will be available for viewing at the Foundation's headquarters at a later date.

An adequate storage place has been found.
